

Our use of cookies

Our website uses cookies, as almost all websites do, to better your experience while visiting the website.

Our cookies help us make our website work as you'd expect.

Cookies are small files saved to the user's computer hard drive that track, save and store information about the user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server to provide the users with a tailored experience within this website.

We do not use cookies to:

Collect any personally identifiable information (without your express permission)

Collect any sensitive information (without your express permission)

Pass data to advertising networks

Pass personally identifiable data to third parties

Pay sales commissions

Granting us permission to use cookies:

If the settings on your software that you are using to view this website (your browser) are adjusted to accept cookies we take this, and your continued use of our website, to mean that you are fine with this. Should you wish to remove or not use cookies from our site you can disable cookies on your device, however doing so will likely mean that our site may not work fully as you would expect.

Turning cookies off:

You can usually switch cookies off by adjusting your browser settings to stop it from accepting cookies, but you should be aware that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of this and many other websites that you visit. Disabling cookies will usually result in also disabling certain functionality and features of this site.

Therefore it is recommended that you do not disable cookies.

Types of cookies:

Cookies can be defined as strictly necessary cookies, performance cookies and functional cookies.

None of the cookies that we use on our website store any personally identifiable information.

Strictly Necessary Cookies:

We use a cookie to remember that we have shown you the cookie information bar that appears at the bottom of our site. If you disallow this cookie, then this information bar will show on every page that you visit.

Performance Cookies:

We use Google Analytics which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solution on the web for helping us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience.

These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages that you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content.

We also use a Google "CAPTCHA" anti-spam image on our contact forms, to cut down on spam received from automated mailing bots.

No personally identifiable information is obtained, stored or passed to Google by allowing these cookies.
